



## Skills for Psychological Recovery

*Presented by Melissa Brymer, National Child Traumatic Stress Network*

The NCTSN/NCPTSD Skills for Psychological Recovery (SPR) intervention is a modularized approach to working with disaster survivors in the recovery phase. Participants will practice SPR and how to adapt this intervention for diverse populations and settings.

## Conference Objectives

1. Become familiar with skills to serve survivors of disaster and/or emergency events.
2. Differentiate approaches to serve survivors at different phases following a disaster.
3. Gain experience applying appropriate interventions through practice exercises.
