Nebraska Risk Communication Cadre

The Nebraska Risk Communication Cadre (RCC) presented to state agency Public Information Officers (PIOs) at a Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) Workshop on January 31, 2017. Risk communication messaging is used by emergency management, corrections, public health, behavioral health, and various other agencies to provide public information during a crisis or emergency. At the workshop, participants learned from RCC members the process of working as a team to develop effective messaging. This presentation featured both an overview of the use of messages prepared in advance and available for emergencies, and an active demonstration of the essential components of creating messages.
